

TotalCardiology uses a variety of electronic communications to deliver cardiac rehabilitation virtually. This allows you to receive information and access some services without attending in-person. This can help when appointments are challenging due to scheduling or work commitments, transportation, or mobility issues, or when face-to-face contact is limited (such as during COVID-19).

Your participation in electronic communications is optional. Your decision to consent to receive or withdraw from electronic communications will not affect the care you receive at TotalCardiology.

What to do in the case of an emergency?
